The plain dye terry bath linens and cotton sateen bed linen are made from organically grown cotton certified by GOTS (Global Organic Textile Standard).

Our linen, an ecological, natural and entirely recyclable fibre, is grown in a sustainable way. Alexandre Turpault has chosen a linen that is woven and manufactured in France, tumbled dry, for added softness and a more supple finish.


